Literacy & Languages

At school we will :

- Write a poem/song based on the Vikings
- Write a Non-chronological report, based on an author of their choice.
- Looking at a range of genres and text types
- Writing an adventure story using Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo

At home you can help by:

- Practise weekly spellings
- Put spellings into sentences
- Reading non-fiction pieces

Maths

At school we will :

- Convert decimals to fractions and fractions to decimals
- Recognise tenths and hundredths and represent them in different ways.
- Learn to tell the time from an analogue and digital clock

At home you can help by:

- Showing the children different times
- Looking at bus stop timetables and finding the difference between intervals
- Look at TV guides and finding the difference between time intervals.

Science & Technology

At school we will :

- Identify how different sounds and vibrations are made
- Look at and discuss how distance affects sound and vibrations
- Look at the pitch and volume of different objects
- Identify loud and quiet using different materials
- Type up their song

At home you can help by:

- Experimenting with different materials around the house and discussing what sounds they make and what causes the vibration

Humanities

At school we will :

- Look at Islam in more depth
- Listen to different cultural music and discuss where it comes from
- Research a range of instruments used around the world
- Look at and discuss how music has changed/developed over time

At home you can help by:

- Listening to different genres of music
- Researching instruments from different cultures

Healthy Living

At school we will :

- Discuss the importance of exercise
- Discuss feelings/friendships
- Discuss how different music can affect mood
- Make comparisons between what vikings used to eat and what we eat now.

At home you can help by:

- Discussing and explaining the importance of exercise
- Take a 5-10 minute walk

The Arts

At school we will :

- Create and write our own song
- Play an instrument
- Make a Viking shield or horn using different materials
- Listen to and read lyrics
- Make similarities and comparisons between lyrics and instruments from different decades.

At home you can help by:

- Researching different musical instruments
- Listen to different genres
