Literacy & Languages

At school:

- We will be reading 'Wolves in the Wall' written by Neil Gaiman
- We will be writing a story based on our own choice of animals coming out from the walls
- **At home you can help by:**
- Visit a zoo/farm or watch clips of animals and discuss the way they move and behave
- Share a story and make predictions about what might happen next, talk about key words the author has used and how they make you feel.

Humanities

At school:

- We will be learning about dinosaurs; when and where they lived, what they ate, how paleontologists gather information about them.
- **At home you can help with activities like:**
- Visit the dinosaur gallery at the National History museum or check out the website- <http://www.nhm.ac.uk/visit/galleries-and-museum-map/dinosaurs.html>
- Making your own prehistoric board game!

Maths

At school:

- We will be learning how to draw and read picture graphs and bar graphs.
- We will be learning about fractions.
- **At home you can help by:**
- Conduct your own research to create a graph e.g. colours of cars parked on your road/pieces of fruit and veg eaten each day over a week etc.
- Practising multiplication facts for 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.
- Practising multiplication facts like $3 \times 4 = 12$, $3 \times 40 = 120$.

Healthy Living

At school:

- We will be learning about what makes a balanced, healthy diet.
- In PE, we are swimming and playing hockey.
- **At home you can help with activities like:**
- What do we need in our diet to stay healthy? Design a healthy packed lunch.

Science & Technology

At school:

- We will be learning about different types of rocks (including fossils) and how they are formed.
- We will be learning about soil and soil permeability.
- **At home you can help with activities like:**
- Go fossil hunting at the beach- check the link for suitable sites <https://ukfossils.co.uk/category/kent/>
- Make your own fossil.

The Arts

At school:

- We will be making sculptures in the style of Alberto Giacometti.
- **At home you can help with activities like:**
- Design and make a sculpture of your very own prehistoric creature!
