Communications and Language

At school we will be:

- Enjoying rhymes and demonstrating listening skills by trying to join in with actions or vocalisations.
- Listening to and enjoying rhymic patterns in rhymes and stories.
- Understanding simple sentences (e.g. 'Throw the ball')

At home you can help by:

- Supporting your child to follow simple sentences at home.

Physical development

At school we will be:

- Clearly communicating wet or soiled nappy or pants.
- Showing a desire to help with dressing/undressing and hygiene routines.
- Showing awareness of what a potty or toilet is used for.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to help with their clothing when they get dressed e.g. by pulling up trousers or tights after a nappy has been changed.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

At school we will be:

- Learning to separate from main carer confidently and happily.
- Responding to appropriate boundaries, with encouragement and support.
- Playing alongside others.

At home you can help by:

- Talking to your child about what they have done at Nursery.

Literacy

At school we will be:

- Showing an interest in books and rhymes.
- Repeating words from familiar stories.
- Filling in the missing word or phrase in a known rhyme, story or game e.g. 'Humpty Dumpty sat on a ...'

At home you can help by:

- Reading a story/singing a Nursery rhyme with your child everyday.

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- Saying some counting words randomly.
- Reciting some number names in sequence.
- Beginning to organise objects according to shape or size.

At home you can help by:

- Singing Nursery rhymes that include number i.e. '5 little ducks.'
- Counting the steps/stairs.

Understanding the World

At school we will be :

- Enjoying pictures and stories about themselves.
- Enjoying pictures and stories about their families and other people.
- Learning that they have similarities and differences that connect them to, and distinguishes them from others.

At home you can help by:

- Showing children photographs/pictures of family and friends and talking about differences i.e. hair colour, eyes.

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be:

- Beginning to use representation to communicate in 2D, e.g. drawing a line and saying 'That's me.'
- Experimenting with blocks, colours and marks.

At home you can help by:

Encouraging your child to paint or draw and discussing what their mark making is.

Parents will be invited into our Early Years setting to share learning with their child. Date to be confirmed.
