Communications and Language

At school we will be:

- Listening to others: one to one or in small groups, when conversation interests them.
- Learning to understand more complex sentences, e.g. 'Put your toys away and then we'll read a book.'
- Using language as a powerful means for interactions, sharing feelings, experiences and thoughts.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to talk about their day.

Physical development

At school we will be:

- Using one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. makes snips in paper with child scissors.
- Learning to communicate with adults when hungry or tired or when they want to rest or play.

At home you can help by:

- Supporting your child through encouraging them to make choices for example, "Would you like milk or water?"

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

At school we will be:

- Enjoying responsibility of carrying out small tasks.
- Beginning to form special friendships with another child.
- Learning to adapt behaviour to different events, social situations and changes in routine.

At home you can help by:

- Talking to your child about who they played with that day.
- Encouraging your child to help you with small tasks such as putting their toys away.

Literacy

At school we will be:

- Begin to have some favourite stories, rhymes, songs, poems or jingles.
- Showing interest in illustrations and print in books and print in the environment
- Giving meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint.

At home you can help by:

- Sharing books your child brings home from school and talking about the pictures.
- Talking about your child's pictures they bring home to share.

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- Counting in order to 10.
- Showing an interest in shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects.
- Using positional language through play.

At home you can help by:

- Pointing out shapes that you see for example, "look a square window or a round stone."
- Counting everyday objects while climbing stairs or cooking.

Understanding the World

At school we will be :

- Showing interest in the lives of people who are familiar to them.
- Shows care and concern for living things and the environment.
- Learning to talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to talk about the people in their family and why they are important to them.
- Talking to your children about how the weather is beginning to change and the leaves on the trees are changing colour.

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be :

- Copying and tapping out simple repeated rhythms.
- Exploring and learn how sounds can be changed.
- Building stories around toys, e.g. farm animals needing rescue from an armchair 'cliff.'

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to sing songs that involve different sounds like, if you're happy and you know it clap your hands.
