Communications and Language

At school we will be:

- Maintaining attention, concentrating and remaining engaged for the duration of an activity.
- Responds to simple instructions, e.g. to get or put away an object.
- Links statements and sticks to a main theme or intention.

At home you can help by:

- Support your child to follow simple instructions at home.

Physical development

At school we will be:

- Negotiating space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles.
- Dressing with help, e.g. puts arms into open-fronted coat or shirt when held up, pulls up own trousers, and pulls up zipper once it is fastened at the bottom.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging independence when your child gets dressed for school.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

At school we will be:

- Confident to talk to other children when playing.
- Aware of the boundaries set, and of behavioural expectations in the setting.
- Demonstrating friendly behaviour, joining in with conversations and forming good relationships with peers.

At home you can help by:

- Talking to your child about learning. For example, "What have you learnt today? What have you got better at?"

Literacy

At school we will be:

- Learning to recognise and say most sounds in the alphabet.
- Orally blending sounds together in simple words.
- Hearing and saying the initial sound in words.
- Orally segmenting the sounds in simple words.

At home you can help by:

- Reading with your child **everyday** and encouraging your child to say some sounds in words.
- Practicing High Frequency Words **everyday**.

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- Counting up to 20 objects.
- Recognising numerals 0-20
- Beginning to use mathematical names for 'flat' 2D shapes.
- Ordering two or three items by length or height.

At home you can help by:

- Looking for different numbers in the environment.
- Counting everyday objects while climbing stairs or cooking.

Understanding the World

At school we will be :

- Knows about important role within the community. For example, teachers, police officers, firefighters.
- Looks at, and can talk about, changes in their world. For example, noticing the changes in plants as they grow.
- Children can take a photograph using ICT equipment. For example, using an iPad or camera.

At home you can help by:

- Encourage your child to take photos using iPads or phones of special family events or days out.

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be :

- Learning the names of the primary colours.
- Learning the names of the secondary colours.
- Creating simple representations of events, people and objects. For example, paints a picture of their family.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to paint or draw and discussing the outcome
