## Literacy & Languages

*At school we will :*

- Listen and respond with the confidence to speak out in both small groups and a class setting.
- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words
- Listening to and discussing a wide range of poems, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which they can read independently

*At home you can help by:*

- Read comics, home reading book, reading eggs activities.
- Talk about the pictures in your reading book and answer simple questions
- Learn weekly spellings

## Maths

*At school we will :*

- Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.

*At home you can help by:*

- Make a game of snap with 0-20 in words and numbers.
- How far can you count forwards and back from 0 - 100?
- Weekly Athletics activities

## Science & Technology

*At school we will :*

Observe changes across the 4 seasons.

Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

Design a shelter

Use the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes

*At home you can help by:*

- Discuss the seasons and how the weather changes.
- Make a rain gauge or a wind sock.
- Make a weather report video with your iPad

## Humanities

*At school we will :*

- Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
- Investigate homes around the world and compare them.

*At home you can help by:*

- Find which countries of the world are hot and cold.
- Find which countries have the same seasons as the UK.
- Find Kent on a UK map

## Healthy Living

*At school we will :*

- Master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.

*At home you can help by:*

- Timing how many jumps you can do in a minute, can you beat your score week on week?
- Find how many times you can catch a ball in 1 minute.

## The Arts

*At school we will :*

- Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

*At home you can help by:*

- Make a collage of things found in a park or your garden.
- Find out who Andy Goldsworthy is and make your own nature sculpture.
- Take photos of nature with your iPad
