Communications and Language

At school we will be:

- Learning to retell a simple past event in correct order for example; yesterday I hurt my finger.
- Learning to find how and why things happen.

At home you can help by:

Literacy

At school we will be:

- Learning about different ways a story could end.
- Recognising their name in written form.

At home you can help by:

- Reading to your child every evening and talking about the ending.
- Showing your child their name in written form.

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be:

- Experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- To explore different colours and what happens when they get mixed together.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to recognise a range of primary colours in the environment.
- Talking about the colours you can see when out.

Physical development

At school we will be:

- Teaching the children to hold their pencil in a tripod grip.
- Learning to understand why it is important to wash your hands before eating.

At home you can help by:

- Giving your child things such as blue tack to strengthen their hand muscles.
- Talking to your child about how to stay healthy.

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- Learning to count objects in order.
- Learning to recognise common 2D shapes.

At home you can help by:

- Counting when climbing the stairs.
- Identifying 2D shapes in the environment.
