Literacy & Languages

At school we will :

apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words.

At home you can help by:

- Read daily at home and answer questions on what you have read.
- Use reading eggs to support reading and spellings.

Maths

At school we will :

read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.

At home you can help by:

- Use mathematics and complete the weekly task.
- Can you find the numbers that make 10?

Science & Technology

At school we will :

- distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock

At home you can help by:

- Discuss items in your home, what they are made from and their properties.
- Can you make a waterproof wrapper for a toy?

Humanities

At school we will :

- changes within living memory. Where appropriate, these should be used to reveal aspects of change in national life e.g. art

At home you can help by:

- Look at wrapping paper and design your own either for a Christmas gift or birthday.
- Who invented wrapping paper and cards?

Healthy Living

At school we will :

- perform dances using simple movement patterns.

At home you can help by:

- discussing what makes a healthy choices for a lunch box.
- Design a poster on pic collage app to show what should be included in a healthy lunch box.
- Invent a healthy snack that we could make in class.

The Arts

At school we will :

- generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through talking, drawing, templates, mock-ups and, where appropriate, information and communication technology

At home you can help by:

- create a repeating pattern using potato printing.
- Collect design ideas on your ipad.
