Literacy & Languages

At school we will :
develop pleasure in reading, motivation to read, vocabulary and understanding by:

listening to and discussing a wide range of poems, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which they can read independently

being encouraged to link what they read or hear to their own experiences

At home you can help by:

- Listen to your child read every night and record reading evidence in their contact books.
- Find and bring into school to share – stories with a toy theme.
- Make a comic strip about a bear.

Maths

At school we will :

- represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including 0

At home you can help by:

- Going on weekly tasks set on Matheletics
- Count aloud to 100 forwards and backwards.
- Begin to count in 2s and 10s
- Divide amounts of toys between your family

Science & Technology

At school we will : will be naming parts of the body and bones and where to locate them.

At home you can help by:

- Make a junk skeleton.
- Learn the name of the major organs in the body like the heart and say what their job is.
- Make a poster or video on how to keep yourself healthy.
- Design a model of an eye, or another part of your body so you can explain to everyone how it works.
