Communications and Language

At school we will be:

- Learning to listen in a larger group, for example, in an assembly.
- Learning to answer 'how and why' questions about their experiences.
- Learning to use past and future tenses accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to listen during family conversation and respond appropriately.
- Encourage your child to respond to questions about their school day.
- Encourage your child to talk about past and future events.

Literacy

At school we will be:

- Learning to read and understand simple sentences.
- Learning to read and write many High Frequency words.
- Learning to write simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others.

At home you can help by:

- Reading with your child every evening.
- Practising reading and writing HFW with your child.

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be:

- Children explore ways of changing songs they have created.
 - Learning to represent and express ideas through the use of technology.
- At home you can help by:*
- Encouraging your child to listen to a variety of music from different eras and genres.
 - Encouraging your child to paint and draw using the Sketches App on their iPad device.

Physical development

At school we will be:

- Learning to hop and skip in time to music
- Learning to manage basic hygiene needs including dressing and going to the toilet **independently**.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to move in time to their favourite song.
- Encourage to dress **independently** for school.

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- Learning to place a random set of numbers in order.
- Learning to add, subtract and record using objects.
- Learning to use everyday language to talk about weight and capacity.

At home you can help by:

- Support your children to order a set of numbers through home learning.
- Use language to describe the weight of objects when shopping. For example, "This watermelon is much heavier than this apple."

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

At school we will be:

- Learning to talk about plans they have made to carry out activities.
- Learning to adjust their behaviours in different situations.
- Learning to play games with rules.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to share their ideas about activities as they carry them out i.e. When playing Lego - What have they built? Why have they created this? Would you change anything if building it again?
- Sharing behaviour expectations in different situations.
- Sharing game rules before playing.

Understanding the World

At school we will be:

- Learning to identify similarities and differences between themselves and others and among families, communities and traditions.
- Learning about similarities and differences in relation to our adopted animal.
- Learning to retrieve information using the internet safely.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to talk about their family traditions.
- Through home learning, research the habitat of our chosen adopted animal.
- Talking to your child about the safe use of internet.
