Communications and Language

At school we will be:

- Learning to look at, handle and turn pages in books correctly and know that, in English, it is read from left to right and top to bottom.
- Learning to listen to others one to one or in small groups when conversation interests them.

At home you can help by:

- To share books with your children that they bring home from school.
- To encourage your child to take turns in conversations such as my turn and now your turn.

Literacy

At school we will be:

- Learning to sequence a simple story with beginning, middle and end.
- To recognise and write their name in written form.

At home you can help by:

- Reading to your child every evening.
- Showing your child their name in written form and encouraging them to write it down.

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be:

- Learning to imitate movement in response to music.
- Learning to build stories around toys, e.g. farm animals needing rescuing in an armchair "cliff"

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to share their favourite song with you.
- Talking to your children about pretend things and real things.

Physical development

At school we will be:

- Teaching the children to use one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. make snips in paper with child scissors.
- Encouraging children to dress themselves with help.

At home you can help by:

- Supporting your children to use scissors safely.
- Encouraging your children to get ready in the mornings by themselves with help.

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- Learning to match the correct numeral to a group of objects up to 10.
- Learning to recognise more than one shape.

At home you can help by:

- Asking your child if they recognise numbers when out e.g. numbers on the bus.
- Identifying 2D shapes when out and about.

- Supporting the children to be confident in asking adults for help.
- Learning to accept the needs of others and can take turns and share resources.

- Talking to your child about the things they need and who to ask for help.
- Encouraging your child to play games that allow turn taking.

- Looking at ICT equipment to take photographs.
- Developing an understanding of growth.

At home you can help by:

- Showing your children how they can use their iPad devices to take pictures.
- Talking about the plants and trees in the environment.
