Literacy & Languages

At school we will :

- Share the text *Grandpa's Island* by Benji Davies and use this text to write our own stories and letters.
- We will then use the film of 'Finding Nemo' to write our own diary entries from the view of Marlon.

At home you can help by:

- Daily reading including reading eggs.
- Learn weekly spelling on spelling shed
- Bring in seaside stories or fact book about coastline animals
- Research other books by Benji Davies either at the local library, his website or youtube.

Humanities

At school we will :

- Research the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. Some will be used to compare aspects of life in different periods - Grace Darling

At home you can help by:

- Find out why Grace is famous, where and when she lived.
- Find out how you call the emergency services at the coast.
- What do the flags mean at the beach?
- Research where our nearest beaches are. Do they have a lighthouse?

Maths

At school we will :

- recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
- Learning how to make equal groups by dividing and multiplying.

At home you can help by:

- discussing $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ when cutting sandwiches, pizzas, cakes.
- Weekly mathematics challenge
- Take a set number of objects i.e 12 pennies and find out different groups of equal amounts that you can make.

Healthy Living

At school we will :

- Use the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes based on the diet of the lighthouse keeper stories.
- We will be looking at his lunches and designing a balanced meal.

At home you can help by:

- Design a sandwich for the Lighthouse keeper or create a nasty tasting sandwich to stop the seagulls eating the lunch.
