Communications and Language

At school we will be:

- Learning to follow instructions involving several ideas or actions.

At home you can help by:

Literacy

At school we will be:

- To recognise their name in written form.

At home you can help by:

- Reading to your child every evening.
- Showing your child their name in written form

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be:

- Experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- To explore different colours and what happens when they get mixed together.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to recognise a range of primary colours in the environment.
- Talking about the colours you can see when out.

Physical development

At school we will be:

- Teaching the children to show good control and co-ordination in small movements.
- To be able to find new ways of moving.

At home you can help by:

- Encouraging your child to paint and draw.
- Encouraging your children to find new ways to move when out and about.

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- Learning to count 10.
 - Learning to recognise more than one shape
- ### *At home you can help by:*
- Counting when climbing the stairs.
 - Identifying 2D shapes when out and about.
